

## HINTON-IN-THE-HEDGES MILLENNIUM CENSUS.

A census was conducted in December 1999 for the parish of Hinton-In-The-Hedges, Northamptonshire. The parish covers an area of 1450 acres and averages 132.5m above sea level. There is a church of probable Saxon origins, a pub and 72 dwellings including 6 farms.

### POPULATION.

Human. Total 198 (101 males 97 females). Average size of household 2.75 persons.

Most popular breeds Labradors and Jack Russell Terriers.

Other breeds represented were Beagles, Dalmations, Australian Terriers, West Highland White Terriers, Border Terriers, German Shepherds, Pointers, Boxers, Corgis, Springer Spaniels, Border Collies and Norwich Terriers.

Small mammals. 4 Rabbits, 4 Guinea pigs.

fish. Indoors: 3 Goldfish, 14 Tropical fish.

Outdoors: 36 Goldfish, 3 Shubunkins, 2 Koi carp, 1 Comet.

Birds. 120 Turkeys, 23 Chickens, 18 Geese, 6 Bantams, 2 Muscovy Ducks.

61% of households have 1 or more pets.
